

# Details of Deaf Camp 2011 Schedule

## Morning Session

6:00 - 6:30 am (30+) Wake up, brush teeth, make beds, clean rooms, wash clothes, etc. Deaf must stay in or close and around their houses.

6:45 - 7:00 (15) Morning Devotions in chapel (All deaf and hearing must be present.)

7:00 - 7:35 (35+) breakfast, washing dishes, Counselors be quick to lead deaf in line

## Forenoon Session

7:45 - 8:00 (15) washing dishes – all others go to chapel for singing

8:00 - 8:25 (25) Bible story video and slide show

**8:25 - 10:45 (140) (small children have separate classes)**

8:25 - 9:40 (75) teaching sessions divide into groups, required rest time for counselors **off** duty

9:40 - 9:55 (15) break time. Counselors, make sure deaf have a chance for water, restroom, etc.

have deaf back seated in their classes five minutes ahead of time.

9:55 - 10:45 (50) teaching session divide into groups, required rest time for counselors **off** duty

10:45 - 11:20 (35+) ASL video classes in chapel for all deaf

10:45 - 11:20 (35) counselors meeting to discuss daily problems and plan next day

11:30 - 12:30 (60) **noon meal** (Counselors, do not waste time) for washing dishes check schedule or listen to announcement

## Afternoon Session

12:30 - 1:30 (60) rest time, washing dishes, all children must be put to bed, adults may rest, but listen to announcement

**1:00 - 2:00 (60) Couple's class (remember they still have a hour Activity time)**

1:30 - 3:00 (90) activities; arts and crafts (listen carefully to announcements on where to go) Counselors, let encourage deaf to do their part, but you can be an example

3:00 - 4:00 (60) snack time; (selling lines might open earlier.) If deaf do not have money, collect some money from chief counselors; all deaf shall be able to buy a little something at least some days. This is a very special time for the deaf; let them enjoy their friends; enjoy your own snack & fellowship. Strictly no snacks are allowed in rooms!

4:00 - 6:00 (120) clean up time; shower hour. (Do deaf have enough clean clothes?) Some deaf may go shower before everyone is done with snacks. Deaf can wash their own clothes if needed.

**The laundry room cannot be used unless a chief counselor approves it.**

**6:00 - 6:45 (45) evening meal** (counselors, are you ready?)

6:45 - 7:30 (45+) fun time;

## Evening Session

7:40 - 7:50 (10) Evening service; Make sure **all your** deaf are sitting in front

7:50 - 8:10 (20) Bible story drama

8:10 - 8:20 (10) choir groups

**8:20 - children classes go to sleep**

8:20 - 9:00 (40+) **message**

9:10 - 9:40 (30+) night snack; everyone gets a cookie or something. Go to rooms.

9:50 - 10:00 (10) bedtime devotions; all counselors shall have devotion and prayer maybe your deaf can do it to.

10:00 - (480) everyone in bed (**Lights out!**) **remember, lights out!!!**

**Counselors**, be sure you know where a chief counselor's window is on open duty. The chief counselors are there to help. Do not be ashamed to go for help at or anytime in the night. Counselors shall know which chief counselors is off duty leave them alone.

**Schedule will be announce through loud speaker**
